★SDMS has exclusive use of the PHR Equestrian Center. The facilities include an air conditioned clubhouse with covered patio. We will have our group meals here and it will be an excellent place for playing cards, indoor games, etc. In this area, there are also two clean vaulted toilets and two showers.

★We have secured a Reddy Ice Trailer for the event. For your convenience, Ice will be available for purchase on site. Prices include the rental fee of the trailer, SDMS will not profit from the sale of the Ice.

★ Feel Free to Ride at will on the Trails as much as you desire! Safety first at all times! Ride with a partner and let someone know your location. Helmets are *required* for riders under 18 yrs old and are *encouraged* for adults. You must be over 15 years of age to ride or drive alone on the trails.

★Pets are welcome but must be on a leash at all times. Pets may not be left unattended outside.

★An **original Proof of Negative Coggins** dated within 12 months of September 3, 2010 is required for every animal! No copies will be accepted. Any out-of-state animals must have a **Health Certificate** dated within 60 days of September 3, 2010. Animals without correct documentation will not be permitted. PH Ranch officials will also check everyone at the event.

### Directions to the Equestrian Center:

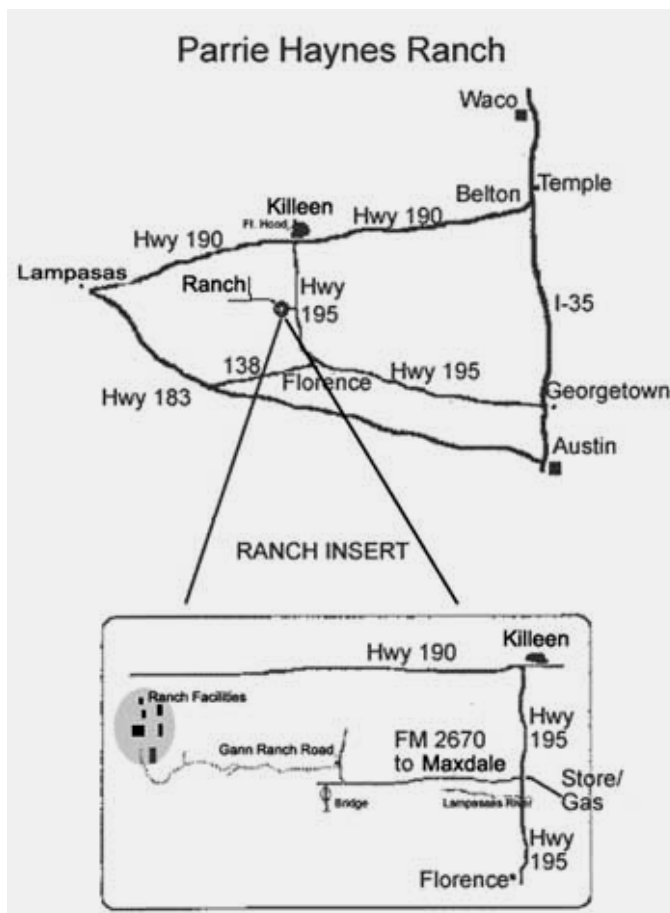
**Traveling from Waco I-35S**, take Hwy 190 west at Belton. In Killeen turn south on Hwy 195 for about 13 miles then turn right on FM 2670 at the blue "Parrie Haynes Youth Ranch" sign. Go 3.7 miles and take a right on Maxdale Road; **the equestrian entrance is 2.2 miles north on Maxdale Road on the left, past the main ranch entrance**. The entrance to the camp is through the second set of double aluminum gates.

**Traveling from Austin I-35N**, take Hwy 195 north (exit 266) for 24 miles; go through Florence and cross the Lampasas River, then turn left on FM 2670 at the blue "Parrie Haynes Youth Ranch" sign. Go 3.7 miles and take right on Maxdale Road; **the equestrian entrance is 2.2 miles north on Maxdale Road on the left, this is past the main ranch entrance**. The entrance to the camp is through the second set of double silver gates.

I understand that, Under Texas law (*Chapter 87, Civil Practice and Remedies Code*), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. I certify that I am fully aware of, and (1) assume all risks and hazards inherent in the participation of the above equine activity, where known hazards exist by generally common accepted fact; and (2) assume all risks and hazards inherent in the use of the Parrie Haynes Ranch Equestrian Center, where known hazards exist by generally common accepted fact. I further understand that I must ride/handle/drive in a safe manner at all times. I further certify that, if I am signing this waiver and release of claims for my child, that this child has been offered animal safety instruction when required.

In consideration of permission to participate in this event, I, and/or my representatives, heirs, executors, and assigns agree to WAIVE, RELEASE, ACQUIT, INDEMNIFY, HOLD HARMLESS, AND FOREVER DISCHARGE the Southwestern Donkey & Mule Society, any property owner of facilities included in the event, and/or their agents, heirs, and assigns, from all civil causes of action (*whether arising under the laws of the State of Texas and/or the United States of America*), damages, liabilities, costs, controversies, claims, demands, contracts, rights and privileges, of every nature and description whatsoever, whether or not such damage is caused by intentional tort, gross negligence, negligence, carelessness, defects in equipment or facilities, whether latent or patent or by any other cause of action whether known or unknown.
