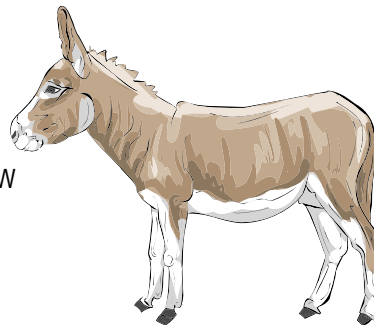

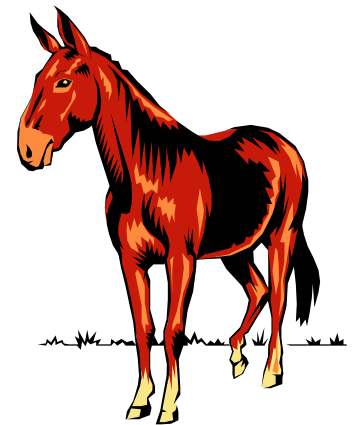

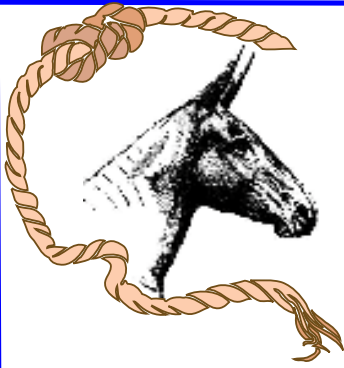

*We have survived another Fort Worth Stock Show!*

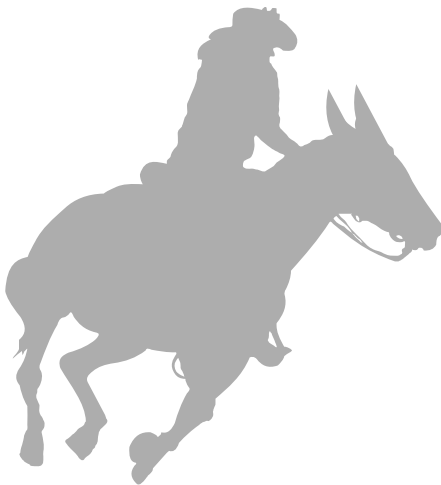

### **Winter Weather Comfort Check!**

**Asses body heat:** Frigid ear tips, body tenseness or shivering and tail clamping can be a sign your animal is too cold and needs blanketing— sweating under the blanket means he needs "dressing down."

**Ward off Colic :** To lower the risk of colic during these days of winter, keep animals well hydrated. Break up ice and warm water if possible. Animals prefer drinking water that's 45 to 65 degrees.

At the Longears Festival held last summer, Drs. Frank and Marsha Stein presented a veterinary clinic to attendees. During the clinic, Marsha and Frank reviewed a list of items to have on-hand in the event of an emergency. ### Basic Emergency Kit Materials For Your Critters

**Scarlet Oil Spray** - Promotes Healing and is an Antiseptic for open wounds

**Betadine Scrub** - Antibacterial Soap for critters and humans - can be used in open wounds

**Isopropyl Alcohol** - Antiseptic cleansing agent - not particularly good for open wounds

**Hydrogen Peroxide** - Good cleansing agent for open wounds - use for a day or two and quit !!!

**4 rolls of 4" White cotton gauze** - To wrap, cover and stabilize wounds or limbs

**3 rolls of 6" Brown gauze** - To wrap, cover and stabilize wounds or limbs

**1 Bottle of water** - To clean or wash critters or people

**3 rolls of Vet Wrap** - To securely cover a wound - sticks to itself without tape - **be careful** - it can very easily be pulled down too tight and cut off circulation

**4 pairs of Exam gloves** - If you don't want to get your hands messy

**Small flash light** - Comes in real handy in low light situations

**Roll of duct tape** - If it can't be fixed with duct tape - it probably can't be fixed - great for foot

and shoe issues

**Super glue** - Can be used to close small lacerations that are just skin deep

**Alluspray** - Good aerosol bandage to protect scrapes and wounds that aren't covered

**NFZ powder** - Antibiotic powder to puff into a wound or lesion to help with infection

**Buta Paste** - To relieve pain and inflammation in equine - **Prescription Item from a Vet**

**Cotton tipped applicator sticks** - Good to retrieve a foreign body from a lesion

**1 roll 4" Elastikon** - Very strong fabric tape - **be careful** - this item is usually used to keep "under bandages" in place and it can very easily be pulled down too tight and cut off circulation

**1 roll of 1" Cloth tape** - similar to elastikon

**1 roll of 1" Bandage tape**

**Digital thermometer** (with instructions)

**Plastic container** - to be used as a liquid basin if needed

**Gauze 4"x 4" pads** - to clean or wash wounds

**Small forceps** - to hold or grab something

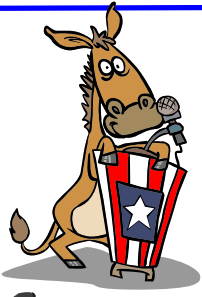
**Medium forceps** - to hold or grab something

**Bandage scissors** - to cut bandage material

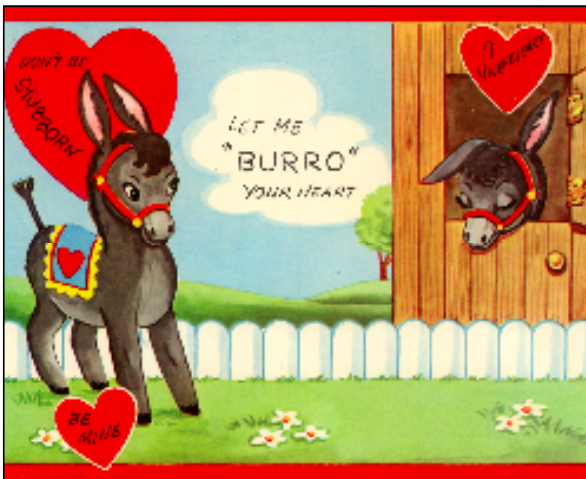
**Rubber tubing** - can be used as a tourniquet

**1 lb. Cotton roll** - bandage padding
